



How to make.....

Super-shiny Fish

Lots of fish have super-shiny scales. See how blingy you can make your fish!

You will need:

Blingy fish template
Card
Silver foil or other shiny material
Sparkles, glitter, foil bottle tops – anything shiny you can find!
Glue or sticky tape
Scissors

What to do:

Print the template on to the card, and cut out the shapes.

Alternatively, print the template on to paper, cut out the shapes and then draw round them on to cardboard. Cut out the cardboard shapes.

However you have made your fish shapes, cover them with foil or other shiny material, and add as much glitter, sparkle and bling as you can.







How to make.....

Paper plate fish

When Jesus told his friends to put their nets into the water they caught so many fish that the nets almost broke!

You will need:

Paper plates (or circles of card)
Colours
Pens

Scissors
Sparkles if you have them
Googly eyes if you have them

What to do:

Cut a wedge from the paper plate.

Cut the wedge in half.

Cut one half in half again, so you have one big "slice" and two small ones.

Stick the big slice at the back of the fish for the tail, and the two small ones at top and bottom to make the fins.

Decorate the plate to make a beautiful fish. Stick on a googly eye if you have them, otherwise just draw one on.







How to do.....

Sandwich Boats

Any age

Sarah remembers being invited to the Vicarage for tea when she was a little girl, and having sandwich boats made from a long thin roll filled with butter, and with a cocktail stick and cheese slice for a sail.

If you don't have a hot dog roll or any cheese slices in the house, perhaps you could improvise......

You will need:

Whatever you can find in the fridge / your kitchen Lots of imagination

How to do.....

A fishing boat

Age 2+

When Jesus rose from the dead on Easter morning he told his special friends to go back to Galilee. They took out their boat and went fishing.....

You will need:

Card / cereal packet Boat template
Colours Sticky tape

Scissors Pipe cleaners/fuzzy sticks if you have them

What to do:

Print the template on to the card, *or* print it on to paper, cut out and draw round it to transfer the shape to the cereal packet.

Cut out.

Colour and decorate your boat. (If you use wax crayons, and colour a good thick layer you may be able to float your boat in water without it becoming too waterlogged).

Fold up and stick the sides with sticky tape. Make some benches, like in the picture.

You could also make some people out of the pipe cleaners/fuzzy sticks if you like.







How to

Make a camp fire model

Jesus had built a camp fire so they could all have a barbeque breakfast on the beach.

You will need:

Kitchen roll middles if you have them. Otherwise cut strips from cereal packets and roll up.

Coloured paper (brown, yellow, red, orange) *or* coloured pages from magazines *or* colour your own paper with colours or paint.

Some washed stones from the garden

Paper plate, or circle of card

Glue

Sticky tape

What to do:

Stick the garden stones around the rim of the paper plate.

Cut the kitchen roll tubes in half, then colour or cover them with brown paper.

Arrange them inside the circle of stones so they look like logs.

Cut out flames from the coloured paper and stick everything into place.

Imagine cooking your freshly caught fish over the camp fire!







How to make.....

A Prayer Net

God catches all our prayers.....

You will need:

2 sheets of A4 paper, coloured if possible Sticky dots or tape or glue

Colours and a pen Scissors

Ruler and pencil Prayer fish template printed on to paper or thin card

What to do:

Measure and cut out two strips 3 cm wide and three strips 1.5cm wide from the long side of one A4 sheet.

Measure and cut out two strips 3 cm wide and three strips 1.5cm wide from the short side of the second A4 sheet.

Use the 3cm wide strips to make a frame the same size as an A4 sheet.

Fasten one of the short 1.5cm strips halfway along the long side of the frame, and the other two half way between this one and the edges.

Weave the long strips in and out from one short side to the other, to make the net, and fasten.

Colour the prayer fish and write a prayer on each one.

Cut them out and fasten them to the net.
