Although we are not gathering for worship there are still expenses to be paid. We are currently seeing expenses being around £1000 more than income each month. If you usually make your offering by putting an envelope or cash on the plate each Sunday, you might like to consider changing this method at least for the time of lockdown.

The **Parish Giving Scheme** is an easy way to set up a regular Direct Debit to the church from your own bank account. If you are a tax payer, the scheme is able to recover Gift Aid monthly and transfer this to the church. The Parish Giving Scheme does not make a charge either to the church or the individual making the gift.

To set up a direct debit you simply need to telephone 0333 002 1271 and will need to have to hand your bank account details and the name and reference details for the church. These are:
