The Area Dean presents Paul to the Bishop

Bishop I present to you the Revd Paul Day to be admitted to the cure of souls in this parish. I therefore ask you to admit him to his new ministry as Vicar of Shirley.

Bishop Thank you for your presentation.

Do those with responsibility to represent the parish confirm this

presentation?

The Parish representatives say

We confirm that we have willingly shared in this choice.

Bishop Paul, God has called you to serve as Vicar of Shirley. Are you ready and

willing to accept this responsibility, with both its duties and its joys?

Paul With the help of God, I am.

Bishop People of God, is it therefore your will that Paul should be admitted to the

cure of souls for this place?

All It is!

Bishop Will you uphold and support him in his ministry?

A// We will!

A moment of stillness and silent prayer as we invite the Holy Spirit to move amongst us and to equip Paul with all the needful gifts of grace for this new ministry.

The Declaration and Oaths

The Declaration of Assent

The Church of England is part of the one, holy, catholic and apostolic Church worshipping the one true God, Father, Son and Holy Spirit. It professes the faith uniquely revealed in the Holy Scriptures and set forth in the catholic creeds, which faith the Church is called upon to proclaim afresh in each generation. Led by the Holy Spirit, it has borne witness to Christian truth in its historic formularies, the Thirty-nine Articles of Religion, the Book of Common Prayer, and the ordering of Bishops, Priests and Deacons.

In the declaration you are about to make will you affirm your loyalty to this inheritance of faith as your inspiration and guidance under God in bringing the grace and truth of Christ to this generation and making him known to those in your care?

Paul responds:

I, Paul Geoffrey Day, do so affirm, and accordingly declare my belief in the faith which is revealed in the Holy Scriptures and set forth in the catholic creeds and to which the historic formularies of the Church of England bear witness: and in public prayer and administration of the sacraments I will use only the forms of service which are authorised or allowed by Canon.

The Oath of Allegiance

Paul, holding a Bible in his right hand (and facing the congregation), says:

I, Paul Geoffrey Day, do swear that I will be faithful and bear true allegiance to Her Majesty Queen Elizabeth the Second, her heirs and successors, according to law. So help me God.

The Oath of Canonical Obedience

Paul, holding a Bible in his right hand (and facing the Bishop), says:

I, Paul Geoffrey Day, do swear by almighty God that I will pay true and canonical obedience to the Lord Bishop of Birmingham, and his successors, in all things lawful and honest. So help me God.

The Licensing

The Bishop reads the parchment and then says

Paul, receive this cure of souls, which is both yours and mine; in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit.

All Amen.

The Blessing of the New Ministry

The Bishop anoints Paul with the oil of Chrism, saying

Paul, remember your baptism into Christ. Remember your ordination in the Church of God.

May God who anointed Jesus Christ with the Holy Spirit anoint and empower you for the blessing of God's people.

All Amen.

Paul is joined by his family. The Bishop commends them to the prayers of the people. Bishop

The Lord bless you and watch over you;

The Lord make his face to shine upon you and be gracious to you;

The Lord look kindly upon you and give you peace.

And the blessing of God Almighty,

the Father, the Son and the Holy Spirit, be with you,

and upon all that you undertake in his name, now and for ever more.

All Amen.

The Installation and Induction

The Bishop addresses the Archdeacon:

Archdeacon, I have licensed Paul to the cure of souls in this parish. I now ask you to install him and by the authority of this mandate to induct him as Incumbent of this parish

The Archdeacon places Paul in the seat of the vicar and says:

Paul, I place you in the seat of the Vicar of Shirley. May the Lord guard and keep you and bless your ministry here, in the name of Almighty God, the Father, the Son and the Holy Spirit.

Paul Amen.

Amen

Kneeling in his stall, Paul prays:

God, who in generous mercy sent the Holy Spirit upon your Church in the burning fire of your love: grant that we, your people in this place, may be fervent in the fellowship of the gospel that, always abiding in you, we may be found steadfast in faith and active in service; through Jesus Christ your Son our Lord.

The Archdeacon and the Churchwardens escort the Vicar to the door.

With the Vicar's hand placed on the church door, the Archdeacon says:

Paul, with the authority of this mandate, I induct you into the real and actual possession of this Benefice of Shirley and all the rights, dignities and responsibilities belonging to it.

The Vicar rings the church bell

The Churchwardens give the Vicar the keys of the church saying: Receive these keys as a sign of your stewardship and let the doors of this place be open to all. Vicar Amen
