



## Sign post

St Paul travelled a long way both in the countries at the Eastern end of the Mediterranean and finally when he was taken to Rome. Mostly people navigated by the stars and there were not many maps. I don't know whether they had signposts although we know the Romans had milestones but this seemed a good way to remind ourselves of some of the places that Paul went to.

### You will need:

A sheet of coloured paper  
Scraps of paper another colour  
Felt tip pen  
Glue stick  
Scissors

### What to do:

1. Start by rolling the piece of paper very tightly and gluing the end in place so that you have a sturdy post.
2. Cut thin strips of the other paper fold then in half and write the names of where St Paul was going on both ends of the paper. I have trimmed the ends into points and written Athens, Damascus, Jerusalem and Rome. You may know some other places that he went to.
3. Glue the side of the paper strip that you haven't written on and fix them to the post.
4. Use some blutack to get your signpost to stand up.
